MISSIONS

JACO & ILKE (Madagascar)

Jaco and Ilke have served the nation of Madagascar since 1996, starting a Bible School, and planting more than 300 churches. Living Word Madagascar was established in 2013, flourishing through Jesus' grace and love. In 2022 God called them to start a

love. In 2022 God called them to start a school, teaching students from diverse backgrounds Bible-based, Christ-centred values. The Wellness Centre established in 2007 has served over 1,4 million meals throughout the past 17 years, serving the poorest of poor on the outskirts of Antananarivo.

DERICK (Russia)

Derick's ministry is in Tula, Russia. He teaches and equips believers in prayer and prophetic ministry. He believes the Lord will take them deeper into street evangelism, prayer, prophetic ministry, teaching, and discipleship in the next season. Derick's vision is to have 24-hour worship and prayer sessions and be a House of Prayer in Russia. They aim to involve all churches in Tula and pray that the vision will burn and grow in the hearts of all the believers.

DAVE & FRANCIS

(Russia/Armenia)

Dave and Francis have been in ministry for almost

30 years. They were called to Russia where they have been faithfully

serving numerous churches through ministry and evangelism, with a strong focus on teaching. They have material available in different languages. In the last few years, their ministry has expanded into Armenia with the testimony of God's miracle-working power opening more opportunities with every trip.

JOHNNETTA & FOUAD


(Belgium)

Johnnetta and Fouad's evangelical ministry is aimed at the influx of immigrants from Middle Eastern countries. For the immigrant communities where "community" is everything, it has been difficult to adapt to the Belgian individualistic worldview. Johnnetta and Fouad's heart is to connect immigrants with others in the community, thereby providing them with a solid basis from which to start their new lives in a new country and, in the process, meet Jesus!

JOHAN & KERRIE (Canada)

Johan and Kerrie work under the indigenous Indian people groups ("First

Nations") of Canada. The biggest problems they are faced with are the lack of identity, self-worth, alcoholism, and drug abuse. As professionally trained counsellors, they provide counselling services which serve as a means to evangelise people. They aim to make "followers of Jesus" and not merely "Christians", as the history of Christianity in Canada has been scarred and the word "Christianity" is not welcome in the Indian population.

MARYNA (India/Russia) Marvna has worked in Kursk, Russia, since 2002 and in Tamil Nadu, India. since 2010. She has been arrested in Russia, India and Bosnia for preaching the Gospel. She has planted churches, evangelism schools, sewing centres for training housewives, rehabilitation stations, and recruitment offices for job seekers. She has also established "widow kindergartens" where elderly widows look after younger widows' children while the younger women go to work. They have saved many temple prostitutes. They also bought children dedicated as temple prostitutes, restored their dignity, and planted children's homes which provide a safe haven to grow up in.

JOHANN (India/Nepal)

Johann's mission is to evangelise the people of India/Nepal. He has been ministering part-time since 2010 and full-time since 2014. The main focus of his mission is to evangelise and serve the widows, orphans, and destitute people according to James 1:27. He also ministers in village churches in the community where he lives and uses the Jesus Film as an evangelism tool. In Nepal, Johann has been doing friendship evangelism and sharing the gospel, while teaching English in a Buddhist monastery.

JC (Malawi) JC is working under Mission Kairos and his focus is on reaching the Yao People. They have taken hands with Judea Harvest to build 100 churches in Malawi. Thousands of the Yao people have already come to Christ and God is doing amazing miracles! The Kairos boat travels around Lake Malawi to visit all the villages and churches around the lake. They have also established selfsustaining gardens that feed 40 families in missions.

ALTHEA

(Malawi/Southern Africa,

Althea coordinates

children's ministry training and development for leaders, parents, and children's workers in Southern Africa. Her ministry is based on Matthew 18:14 and Psalm 8:2, targeting people of the 4/14-Window to reach the 10/40-Window. Together with CEF and YWAM Frontier Missions, they train children's workers to reach, teach, and disciple children to engage in missions and pray for unreached people groups, preparing missional families and missionaries for field service.

SABIE & LIENTJIE

(East London/Transkei)
Sabie and Lientjie are

leaders of Kingdom Youth Club, working with CATCH Projects to provide food security to many families and develop farming skills. The "Child at Heart" foundation took hands with the ECD to uplift and develop the informal crèches in the township areas where poverty-stricken families are identified and empowered. They also have children's clubs where 700 children are given weekly warm meals and life skills are developed.

DRIES & RENTIA (SA)

Dries and Rentia have been in full-time ministry since 1978 under the "Light

for the Nations Ministry" banner. As a team, they are constantly spreading the Gospel to various nations in South Africa and the Indian Ocean Islands. A convert from Islamic Comoros has been a leader in the church for many years and works on translating the Bible into local languages.

Thousands of French Bibles have been printed and "imported". The Church in Comoros is still persecuted. Young believers continue fearlessly. Immigrants from Africa are reached with Bible passages.

WILLIE & MARIE (SA)

Willie and Marie

Erasmus served with Campus Crusade for Christ in the Middle East, Central Asia, and Africa for 27 years. Their focus is reaching the unreached people groups, including Marie's ministry to women. They are based in South Africa and partner with 167 Christian organisations and churches in Africa. They use the "Jesus Film" and other discipleship resources to reach

INTRODUCTION

Funanani Trust is a Charitable Trust established in 1998 by Rina Norden from within Lewende Woord. While it operates as an independent entity, registered as a Non-Profit Organization and Public Benefit Organisation, Funanani maintains a close and interdependent relationship with Lewende Woord. The Trust's headquarters are situated at Lewende Woord Main in Brummeria, Pretoria, with a dedicated Community Centre in Mamelodi.

KEY PROGRAMMES

Spiritual Growth

Programmes, courses, and workshops addressing individuals' and families' spiritual needs and growth.

Food Security

Teaching communities to establish and maintain sustainable food gardens and ad-hoc food relief in times of crisis or dire need, based on relationship and accountability.

Skills Training

Funanani offers Small Business Skills, Sport, Early Childhood Development Skills Training, Life Skills, and Computer Training. From 2025 they will also be venturing into Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics Skills Training for children and youth.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

Funanani Trust is dedicated to tackling social challenges through Biblically inspired approach. Community At Centre Mamelodi, the Trust offers a variety of impactful and innovative programmes designed to support the poor, oppressed, and marginalised. Evangelism and discipleship are central to these initiatives, which include mentorship, training, counselling, and outreach activities. Collaborating closely with NPOs, civil churches, society, community organisations, and government partners, enhances the effectiveness of these efforts. fostering a stronger and more united community response.

• Counselling and Behavioral Change We provide support for youth, atrisk children, the elderly, women in vulnerable situations, single parents and future parents in overcoming the challenges they face. Our goal is to facilitate positive behavioural changes that help individuals adopt healthy habits and improve their overall well-being.

Volunteerism

We believe our greatest asset is people and we value all our volunteers, whether from within the church, local community, or corporate volunteer programmes. Expertise, time, a shared sense of purpose, and making a meaningful impact within a group

of like-hearted and -minded people, are often more valuable than financial contributions.

CONGREGATIONS CARE

In collaboration with the Lewende Woord Main Leadership and Pastoral and Ministry Teams, dedicated ministry services are provided to members of the congregation. This includes offering care packages to families who qualify, individual ministry support to families, and ad-hoc assistance to job seekers during their employment search. This initiative reflects the Trust's commitment to supporting its spiritual community.

DISASTER RELIEF

As part of a Christian, faith-based network of churches and organisations called RESPOND, Funanani focuses—on equipping communities to respond effectively to disasters. This involves:

- Training churches, NGOs, and communities to handle man-made and natural disasters.
- Coordinating relief efforts in collaborative partnerships and operations to maximize resource efficiency and support.

CITY-WIDE NETWORK BUILDING AND ADVOCACY

Over the years, Funanani Trust has collaborated with the City of Tshwane, academic institutions, research organizations, churches, and NGOs on impactful advocacy initiatives. These projects focus on among other areas:

Women at risk


Communities vulnerable to disasters and the human rights issues involved in handling response, subsequent displacements, and sheltering of victims of disasters
